**PCT-Application EP2004/005815**

The PCT-Application was filed on May 28, 2004 for all PCT member states. The Application relates to a clutch especially for motor vehicles, which is characterized mainly by the actuator which controls the clutch.

The application is pending and the European Patent Office will issue the International Search Report in all probability at the end of this year. I have conducted a search on prior art before filing the application and have delimited the claims against this prior art.

The time limit for entering the regional and national phases ends on

**November 28, 2006.**

However, it is possible to start these national phases earlier, if necessary.

**Austrian Patent Application 995/2004**

The above patent application was filed on June 8, 2004. The application is still pending. The Austrian Patent Office should issue the first Official Letter in spring 2005. Foreign patent application claiming the priority of the above application may be filed until
